



The Orang Utan Standards for the production of «Orang Utan Coffee»

valid per 01.01.2014

1. Standards, inspection and certification

The producers commit themselves to abide by the following standards for the cultivation and the subsequent processing, trade and export of the coffee berries:

- SNI-Standards (Indonesian National Standards for Organic Cultivation)
- Nature Conservation Standards (as stipulated below)
- Inspectors of the internal control system (ICS) examine compliance with the Orang Utan Standards (SNI Standards plus Nature Conservation Standards) in cultivation, processing, trade and export.
- LeSOS controls the compliance with SNI and Orang Utan Standards. LeSOS is an independent, state-accredited Indonesian inspection and certification body for organic production.
- Provided that the inspection report fulfills the requirements, LeSOS will issue a certificate in the name of KAN, the competent authority within the Indonesian Department of Agriculture, the label owner of SNI, as well as the Orang Utan Rainforest GmbH, label owner of the Orang Utan Standards.

2. Nature conservation standards

The Nature Conservation Standards, an integral part of the Orang Utan Standards, request:

- No deforestation of primary forest since 2008 (Aceh Logging Moratorium)
- No hunting, capture, keeping and trade of protected wild animal species (according to Indonesian nature conservation legislation)
- No gathering and trade of protected wild plant species (according to Indonesian nature conservation legislation)
